Presentation 1: Neuroleadership in Challenging Times

Neuroscience is one of the fastest growing areas of interest in contemporary science. To the human brain - survival means acceptance by others. Effective leaders must learn to harness and direct the power of emotion to build trust and improve follower satisfaction, morale and motivation. In this interactive presentation the four Pillars of neuroleadership are mastered.

Presentation 2: The Leadership Revolution
