Leadership is about more than popularity or having a title. Explore what it means to lead with responsibility, serve others, use your influence positively and become a role model within the school community.



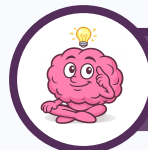
Leading as a Team

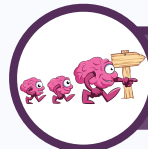
Conflict & Problem Solving
